



Lena Eppelmann is a post-doctoral researcher at Leibniz Institute for Resilience Research (LIR), Mainz, in the area cognitive and behavioral mechanisms of resilience, research group Prof. Dr. Michèle Wessa. The research group investigates the neurobiological and behavioral correlates of central resilience mechanisms as well as the possibilities of behavior modification derived from them through psychological interventions. Eppelmann focused her Ph.D. on school-based prevention of stress-related psychopathology in adolescents at Heidelberg University Hospital. She is a licensed psychotherapist for child and adolescent cognitive-behavioral therapy. Her current research addresses mental health literacy in young people.
